## Description

A 26 years-old women, without any pathological history, admitted to the emergency after appearance of itchy lesions on the eyebrows after application of "Harkous" a plant used for tattooing eyebrows.

Dermatological examination had objected a very limited erythematous plaque, at the level of the eyebrows, very sweaty with vesicles contained clear, in favor of irritating eczema of the eyebrows.
